**Is the person or
entity known to
me?**

Scammers often
impersonate trusted
sources.



**Has their identity
been verified?**

Always confirm through
official contact details, not
links or numbers provided in
the message.



**Am I being rushed or
pressured?**

Scammers create **urgency**
to prevent victims from
thinking through their
decisions.



**Is the payment
method unusual?**

Fraudulent Interac links, as
well as gift cards,
cryptocurrency, and wire
transfers are common
scam tactics.



**Is it too good to
be true?**

Promises of guaranteed
returns or **instant wealth**
are classic scam tactics.



**Have I talked to
someone I trust?**

A **second opinion** from a
trusted family, friend or
Credit Union employee can
help spot a scam.
